

LEAP is a free Learning
Enrichment After School
Program provided by
Independent Living, Inc.
that serves individuals with
developmental disabilities
from Newburgh and
neighboring communities.

With low staff to student ratios and well qualified staff, this unique program provides safe, well planned, person-centered activities and homework assistance at our fully accessible location just off Broadway on the corner of Lake Street and Washington Terrace in Newburgh.

Participants who are in the enrichment program will receive assistance from qualified staff. Participants will also be involved in an array of activities.

Facts About LEAP

- ★ After school enrichment is offered Monday through Friday between 2:00 and 6:00 pm (on regular school days from September through June) at our Newburgh Center at 5 Washington Terrace in Newburgh.
- Transportation to the program from school may be provided by special arrangement with your local school district.
- ★ There is no cost to participants.
- ↑ Parents are responsible for picking their children up at 6:00 pm.
